A new Convention to protect children against sexual exploitation and abuse

The Committee of Ministers has adopted the Convention on the Protection of Children against Sexual Exploitation and Sexual Abuse.

"There should be no hesitation or complacency in the fight against sexual exploitation and abuse of children," said Secretary General Terry Davis, in welcoming the adoption of the convention on 13 July.

This new convention is the first instrument to establish as criminal offences, the various forms of sexual abuse of children, including abuse committed in the home or within the family, with the use of force, coercion or threats.

European Competition 2007: The European Union and nondiscrimination

All European young people from 12 to 18 years old are invited to design a poster on non-discrimination in the EU. Participants will be divided into two age categories (12-14 and 15-18) and must work in groups of at least four.

The entries will be judged first at national level, and prizes will be awarded to the three best teams in each age category at ceremonies to be held in each country on 20 November, International Children's Rights Day. The winners of the first prize in the national competition will compete in a second round at European level.

Deadline for registering is 24 September 2007. Deadline for submitting the work is 31 October 2007.
