High-level conference on the European Social Charter as a tool for employment and social inclusion

The Charter establishes a system of legal standards which help to reduce economic and social tensions while facilitating sustainable and mutually beneficial development in the States Parties. The main subjects to be discussed will be:

- 1) Synergies between the law of the European Union and the European Social Charter;
- 2) The contribution made by the Social Charter's collective complaints procedure to respect for social rights in Europe;
- 3) Austerity measures in times of crisis: impact on social rights, participation by citizens, and the European Social Charter's contribution to overcoming the crisis. (more...)



Ending violence against women must become a top priority

If we look at available data, we can better grasp the urgency of the situation. It is estimated that at least 12 women are killed by gender-related violence in Europe every day. In 2013, available statistics showed that domestic violence claimed the lives of 121 women in France, 134 in Italy, 37 in Portugal, 54 in Spain and 143 in the United Kingdom. In Azerbaijan 83 women were killed and 98 committed suicide following cases of domestic violence, while data collected by the media in Turkey reported that at least 214 women were killed by men last year. Available data covering the first six months of 2014 in many European countries continue to show such alarming figures. (more...)
