Resolution on the promotion of volunteering

On 12th November 2010 the Parliamentary Assembly of the Council of Europe (PACE) has approved a Resolution on the promotion of volunteering.

The resolution is aimed at:

- supporting the 2011 European Year of Volunteering,
- promoting the access to voluntary service
- setting up a social protection system for volunteers
- promoting “food banks”
- encouraging the development of voluntary activities
- creating a legal framework for voluntary work
- recognising that volunteer work is one of the few areas where there exists a balanced participation of women and men and thus build bridges with the political sector.

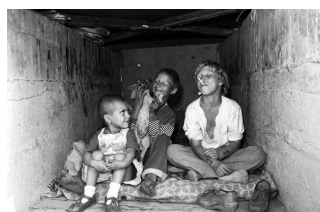


Coyote 16 is available on-line

EU launches Disability Strategy 2010-2020

On 15 November 2010 the European Commission adopted a new strategy to break down the barriers that prevent persons with disabilities from participating in society on an equal basis. The strategy outlines how the EU and national governments can empower people with disabilities so that they can fully enjoy their rights. Specific measures over the next decade range from improving accessibility of goods and services to studying the implications of a mutual recognition of national disability cards.
